Cause of Services Module

S2 Cofanet policy and cash master module

Through this module the *Service entity* grants you a user licence for the Cofanet Policy Master Platform.

The full extent of services, and the conditions of use are described in the policy master and cash master section of the General Service Conditions

Terms in *italics* have a value in the insurance contract and terms in **bold type-face** are defined in the policy master and cash master section of the General Service Conditions.

1 Effective date and term

This module will remain in effect as long as your credit insurance contract is in effect. You may request the removal of this module, and the associated services it provides to you, by providing us with three months written notice.

2 Platform services

The **platform** is designed to help you manage your **contract** by means of the policy master option which provides:

- Consolidated information related to credit limits,
- Alerts which prompt you of your notice and reporting requirements under the contract.

The Cofanet cash master option will provide evidence of the coverage of invoices under the **contract** by means of **cover certificates** which are generated at your request for **invoices** selected by you, under the conditions specified in the policy master and cash master section of the General Service Conditions.

3 Obligations

In order for the **platform** to deliver the services proposed above, you undertake to incorporate in the **platform** the **invoices** and **data** required within the time periods and format provided in the policy master and cash master section of the General Service Conditions.

Failure to enter invoices and data, or failure to do so in a timely manner, will render the platform services as ineffective.

4 Access to the services of the platform

The **platform** services are reserved for you and for your **user[s]**. To protect your access to the **platform**, unique **identifiers** will be sent to you; these **identifiers** are personal and confidential and you are fully responsible for their use. You must take all necessary measures to maintain the security and confidentiality of your **identifiers**.

You may grant access to your **platform** to **third party users**. Access for these **third party users** will be subject to receipt by us of a signed accession endorsement upon when we will provide a specific identifier to the **third party user**. The accession endorsement template and the conditions of access to third parties are specified in the policy master and cash master section of the General Service Conditions.
